### **BLM Rock Springs Holds Public Open House on Resource Management Plan**

The Bureau of Land Management Rock Springs Field Office (RSFO) will hold a public open house on the Rock Springs RMP revision.

The meeting will be on August 24, 2016, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the BLM office, 280 Highway 191 North, Rock Springs, WY.

In response to public interest regarding the status of the Rock Springs RMP revision, the RSFO will hold an open house to answer questions regarding the status and progress of work on the RMP revision. RSFO staff will be available to answer questions regarding: Subjects of public interest, Incorporation of the Greater Sage-Grouse amendment into the RMP, Alternative development, and Schedule.
