





Northeast California Recent Fires



Recently burned areas are displayed for the California portion of the Northeastern California and Northwestern Nevada portion of the Nevada and Northeast California Sub-Region. Data show areas that burned between 2001 and 2011. Land managers use fire history information in

effects analysis, assessing trends, and budget planning. Historic perimeters are used in assessing the effects of wildfire on vegetation and in the assessment of risk to communities, which can be used to assess effects on sage-grouse and their habitats.
