




National Greater Sage-Grouse Planning Strategy

Northeast California Deer and Pronghorn Habitat



Deer and pronghorn use areas are shown for the Northeastern California and Northwestern Nevada portion of the Nevada and Northeast California Sub-Region. Greater sage-grouse management and conservation strategies can be developed in concert with management

strategies for other key wildlife of concern in the planning area. Note that breaks in the data are seen at the California-Nevada state line due to differences in data collection between the states.



- Deer (critical summer range, critical winter range, fall holding area, and fawning ground)
- Pronghorn (kidding grounds, migration corridors, stress migration corridors, and winter range)
- 75% breeding bird density
- 100% breeding bird density
