


Off-Highway Vehicle Management Area Designations



All public lands are required to have off-highway vehicle area designations (see 43 CFR 8342.1). The Resource Management Plan (RMP) off-highway vehicle (OHV) area designations must be classified as one of the following:

- Open: Areas open to travel cross-country
- Limited: Limited in some fashion (spatial, temporal, uses, etc.)
- Closed: Areas where motorized vehicle use is prohibited.

For areas classified as limited, RMPs may consider a full range of possibilities, including travel that will be limited to designated or existing roads and trails; limited to types or modes of travel (e.g., foot, equestrian, bicycle, motorized); limited to time or season of use; limited to certain types of vehicles (OHVs, motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles, high clearance, etc.); limited to licensed or permitted vehicles or users; limited to BLM administrative use only. The RMP Revision will address if the current OHV area designations are still appropriate or if changes are required.
