




# National Greater Sage-Grouse Planning Strategy

## Idaho and Southwestern Montana Recent Wildfires



Recently burned areas are displayed for the Idaho/southwestern Montana sub-region, including BLM and Forest Service lands. Data for Montana show areas that burned between 2000 and 2009, while data for Idaho show areas that burned between 1991 and 2011. Land managers use fire history information in effects

analysis, assessing trends, and budget planning. Historic perimeters are used in assessing the effects of wildfire on vegetation and in the assessment of risk to communities, which can be used to assess effects on sage-grouse and their habitats.
