




National Greater Sage-Grouse Planning Strategy

Idaho and Southwestern Montana Special Designations



Special designations, including Wild and Scenic Rivers, National Monuments, National Conservation Areas, Areas of Critical Environmental Concern (ACEC), Wilderness Study Areas, and Wilderness are displayed for the Idaho/southwestern Montana sub-region, including BLM and Forest Service lands. Wilderness Study Areas and ACECs are BLM administrative designations,

while the other special designations areas were created by presidential proclamation or an act of Congress. Land use plans and management direction for such designations must comply with the purpose and objectives of the proclamation or act of Congress regardless of any conflicts with the BLM's multiple-use mandate.
