BLM Greater Sage Grouse EIS

I am a landowner North of Craig, Co in a priority habitat area. My biggest concern is poaching of sage grouse that takes place on my property along county road 109, (which is a secondary, ungraveled road), in the late summer and early fall. People come in on this county road and slaughter the sage grouse. Along the road are hundreds of acres of grass/alfalfa fields that the sage grouse use extensively for brood rearing. There are also two water sources along the road where the grouse concentrate. We have seen the numbers steadily declining on that portion of our ranch for the past 16 years. On other parts of the ranch, the numbers are stable or increasing where there is no public access. I have notified the CPW of this problem. The only solution I can see is closing that portion of the county road to the public. This would help sage grouse numbers increase in this critical habitat area.
