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## HOW TO USE THIS DOCUMENT



However, decisions made in Chapter 2 and displayed on the maps in this document only apply to BLM-managed lands.



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


**Map 68. Utility Avoidance Areas in the No Action Alternative**




Map 69. ROW Avoidance Areas in Alternative I




Map 70. ROW Avoidance Areas in Alternative II




Map 71. ROW Avoidance Areas in Alternative III




**Map 72. ROW Avoidance Areas in Alternative IV (the Preferred Alternative)**






**Map 74. ROW Exclusion Areas in Alternatives I and III**




**Map 75. ROW Exclusion Areas in Alternative II**




**Map 76. ROW Exclusion Areas in Alternatives IV (the Preferred Alternative) and V**






**Map 78. Wind Resource Potential**




**Map 79. Potential Wind Development Areas in Alternative I**




**Map 80. Potential Wind Development Areas in Alternative II**




**Map 81. Potential Wind Development Areas in Alternative III**




**Map 82. Potential Wind Development Areas in Alternative IV (the Preferred Alternative)**




**Map 83. Potential Wind Development Areas in Alternative V**




**Map 84. Land Tenure Allocations in the No Action Alternative**




Map 85. Land Tenure Zones in Alternative I




Map 86. Land Tenure Zones in Alternative II




Map 87. Land Tenure Zones in Alternative III






Map 89. Land Tenure Zones in Alternative V




### Map 90. Potential Oil and Gas Development Areas




**Map 91. Geothermal Development Potential**




Map 92. Leasable Mineral Allocations in Alternative I




**Map 93. Leasable Mineral Allocations in Alternatives II and III**




Map 94. Leasable Mineral Allocations in Alternative IV-A




**Map 95. Leasable Mineral Allocations in Alternative IV-B (the Preferred Alternative)**




**Map 96. Leasable Mineral Allocations in Alternative V**




Map 97. Salable Mineral Allocations in Alternative I






**Map 99. Salable Mineral Allocations in Alternative III**




**Map 100. Salable Mineral Allocations in Alternative IV (the Preferred Alternative)**




**Map 101. Salable Mineral Allocations in Alternative V**




**Map 102. Areas Recommended for Withdrawal from Locatable Mineral Development in Alternative I**




### Map 103. Areas Recommended for Withdrawal from Locatable Mineral Development in Alternative II




**Map 104. Areas Recommended for Withdrawal from Locatable Mineral Development in Alternative III**




**Map 105. Areas Recommended for Withdrawal from Locatable Mineral Development in Alternative IV (the Preferred Alternative)**




**Map 106. Areas Recommended for Withdrawal from Locatable Mineral Development in Alternative V**




Map 107. Proposed ACECs in the No Action Alternative




Map 108. Proposed ACECs in Alternative I










**Map 112. The Oregon NHT and Toana and Kelton Freight Roads**
