

Jarbidge Field Office Proposed Resource Management Plan and Final Environmental Impact Statement

Lead Agency: US Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management

Type of Action: Final, Administrative

Jurisdiction: Elmore, Owyhee, and Twin Falls Counties, Idaho and Elko County, Nevada

Abstract:

This Proposed Resource Management Plan (RMP) and Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) describes and analyzes the impacts of seven alternatives for managing the public lands administered by the Jarbidge Field Office in southern Idaho. The alternatives provide a variety of methods to guide the multiple-use management of resources and resource uses.

Planning issues addressed include: vegetation, livestock grazing, recreation, energy development, and Areas of Critical Environmental Concern. Vegetation issues are further divided into concerns over fuels treatments, fire rehabilitation, and fire suppression; habitat for fish, wildlife, and special status plants and animals (including greater sage-grouse); and livestock forage.

Protest:

This Proposed RMP and Final EIS is open for a 30-day protest period beginning on the date the Notice of Availability of the Final EIS is published in the Federal Register. A protest may raise only those issues that were submitted during the planning process (see 43 Code of Federal Regulations 1610.5-2). Protests must be filed with the Director, Bureau of Land Management as described in the Dear Reader Letter.
