# Kanab Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Kanab Field Office is preparing a **Resource Management Plan (RMP)** and associated **Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)** for approximately 640,500 acres of public land in south central Utah. The overall objective of the Kanab RMP planning effort is to provide a collaborative, community-based planning approach that assists BLM in updating the management and resource allocation decisions in outdated plans.
