


# Kanab Field Office Travel Routes Crocodile




**NOTE:**

Roads and routes within the Kanab Field Office are mostly dirt, clay, sand, gravel or rocky. These roads and routes are subject to flooding and may be impassable when wet. High clearance four-wheel drive vehicles are recommended for most routes while others may require an ATV. Conditions change, so please inquire at the Kanab Field Office for current driving conditions. Leave gates open or closed as you find them. Routes shown as Non-BLM are for reference and may not be open for travel. Please respect private property. Route signs with BLM route numbers are located on BLM land, not necessarily at route intersections. Not all BLM routes on this map have signs on the ground. "Main BLM Routes" do not indicate a higher level of route quality. Technical 4WD or ATV use may be required.
