


Kanab Field Office Travel Routes Dog Valley

Roads and routes within the Kanab Field Office and Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument are mostly dirt, clay, sand, gravel or rocky. These roads and routes are subject to flooding and impassable when wet. High clearance four-wheel drive vehicles are recommended for most routes while others may require an ATV. Conditions change, so please inquire at visitor centers for current driving conditions. Leave gates open or closed as you find them. Routes shown as Non-BLM and Off Monument are for reference and may not be open for travel. Respect private property.
