RATIONALE / JUSTIFICATION

An area was inadvertently left off the mineral materials map (Figure 9a) for the ROD / Final EIS of the Vernal Resource Management Plan. This area has a long history of prior use. (See attached map for location.)

- Area 1 (250 acres) Sections 30, 31, T6S R25E and Section 6, T7S R25E, SL Meridian, Uintah County. This area is a dimension stone area. Dimension stone is natural stone or rock that has been selected and fabricated (i.e., trimmed, cut, drilled, ground, or other) to specific sizes or shapes. The dimension stone collected from this area is often used as a landscaping product. This area has been used for many years. Private and commercial users are required to obtain the necessary permits from the BLM before material is removed.

The acreage identified in Management Decision MSA-3 from the Vernal ROD / Final EIS and Figure 9a are adjusted to include this addition.
