Item	Page	Paragraph	Change Description
2009-07-001	32	1 st full paragraph	. . . The White River area is managed with a NSO stipulation, and <u>no</u> waivers, exceptions or modifications would <u>for oil and gas leasing will</u> apply.
2009-07-002	43	2 nd paragraph for the White River	. . . This includes 6,680 acres that are part of the White River non-WSA lands with wilderness characteristics and 1,100-2,831 acres which are part of the White River SRMA. For oil and gas leasing, the VRM Class II area would be protected with NSO (12,586-13,243 acres) in the river corridor.

RATIONALE / JUSTIFICATION

2009-07-001. The language is changed to clarify how the White River Non-WSA Land with Wilderness Characteristics will be managed with regards to oil and gas leasing.

2009-07-002. The acreage for the White River SRMA is corrected to be consistent with the rest of the document. See Management Decision SRMA-8. The SRMA consists of two adjoining parcels: one has 1,110 acres and the other has 1,721 acres, for a total of 2,831 acres. The acreage for VRM Class II in this area corrects a GIS mapping error.
