Abstract:

This Supplement to the Draft Resource Management Plan/Draft Environmental Impact Statement describes and analyzes the impacts of a fifth alternative (Alternative E) for managing the public lands administered by the Vernal Field Office in northeast Utah. Alternative E gives emphasis to protection of non-Wilderness Study Area lands with wilderness characteristics but provides management recommendations to guide the multiple use management of all resources. Proposed ACECs, suitable Wild and Scenic River segments, and special recreation management areas are also recommended. Alternative A is the BLM's preferred alternative.
