Description (describe the boundaries of the area--wilderness inventory roads, property lines, etc

The initial inventory boundary was delineated through a GIS exercise based on roads, land ownership and Rights of Way. The road data were digitized by AGRC using ARC/Info from USGS 7.5 Minute quadrangle maps. Roads with codes (1-4, 1 Primary Route, 2 Secondary Route, 3 Primary Road and 4 Secondary Road) were used initially as wilderness inventory roads and field verified during the inventory process to determine if they met the FLPMA definition of a road. This unit is approximately 15 miles north of Enoch and 1 mile west of the Minersville Hwy. The west and North boundaries are based on the Lost Springs road. The east boundary is based on the Lost Springs Hollow –SO road and the southern boundary is based on the Mud Springs Road.

(2) Does the area appear to be natural? Yes No N/A

Description (include land ownership, location, topography, vegetation, and summary of major human uses/activities

The unit is made up of BLM land with approximately 1,200 acres of state land within the unit. The topography is low rolling hills with very little variety. The vegetation is comprised of pinion Juniper woodlands and sage brush. The area does appear to have naturalness in the sense that it is undeveloped. The area does have some two track routes going all the way through it but overall they do not impact the naturalness of the area.

(3) Does the area (or the remainder of the area if a portion has been excluded due to unnaturalness and the remainder is of sufficient size) have outstanding opportunities for solitude?

Description (describe the area's outstanding opportunities for solitude):

This area does not provide outstanding opportunities for solitude due to the low rolling hills, lack of vegetation and close proximity to city and major county roads that provide excellent access to the area.


