(1) Is the area of sufficient size? Yes No

Description (describe the boundaries of the area--wilderness inventory roads, property lines, etc

The initial inventory boundary was delineated through a GIS exercise based on roads, land ownership and Rights of Way. The road data were digitized by AGRC using ARC/Info from USGS 7.5 Minute quadrangle maps. Roads with codes (1-4, 1 Primary Route, 2 Secondary Route, 3 Primary Road and 4 Secondary Road) were used initially as wilderness inventory roads and field verified during the inventory process to determine if they met the FLPMA definition of a road. The north boundary is based on State and Private land. The east boundary is based on state land and Hwy 143/power line ROW. The south boundary is based on private land. The west boundary is based on the Summit Mountain road and RT 031272.

(2) Does the area appear to be natural? Yes No N/A

Description (include land ownership, location, topography, vegetation, and summary of major human uses/activities

The unit is comprised of BLM land and just east of Parowan and NE of Summit. The topography is very steep mountains and cliffs. The vegetation is made up of mixed conifer on upper slopes, and pinyon and juniper woodlands on the lower slopes. The area is very hard to access due to the steep terrain so roads are not present. The few routes that did exist in the area are very well traveled and are considered roads as per the wilderness definition with only a few other ATV routes that go into inventory unit a short distance. The unit is natural in the sense that it has been undeveloped.

(3) Does the area (or the remainder of the area if a portion has been excluded due to unnaturalness and the remainder is of sufficient size) have outstanding opportunities for solitude?

This unit does not have outstanding opportunities for solitude due to its proximity to adjacent towns and easy access from vehicle routes. This area is frequently visited by people from the local area.




