The initial inventory boundary was delineated through a GIS exercise based on roads, land ownership and Rights of Way. The road data were digitized by AGRC using ARC/Info from USGS 7.5 Minute quadrangle maps. Roads with codes (1-4, 1 Primary Route, 2 Secondary Route, 3 Primary Road and 4 Secondary Road) were used initially as wilderness inventory roads and field verified during the inventory process to determine if they met the FLPMA definition of a road. The northern boundary is the main county road; the eastern boundary is a main bladed road. The southern boundary is the gas line ROW and the western boundary is the main road.

Description (include land ownership, location, topography, vegetation, and summary of major human uses/activities.

The area is comprised of BLM land with two state sections within in it and a small private parcel towards the north end. The unit is located approximately 17 miles NW of Beaver Utah. The topography of the area is classic basin and range with a large uplift ridge with bahadas on both sides. The vegetation consisted of cheat grass, piñon juniper, crested wheat grass. The unit has many vehicle routes that are very evident and apparent there is evidence of mining on the west side with a road being cut into the side of the slope there is a big game guzzler along with range improvements such as fences and reservoirs. The area does not appear to be undeveloped and does not meet the naturalness criteria.


