Description (describe the boundaries of the area--wilderness inventory roads, property lines, etc

The initial inventory boundary was delineated through a GIS exercise based on roads, land ownership and Rights of Way. The road data were digitized by AGRC using ARC/Info from USGS 7.5 Minute quadrangle maps. Roads with codes (1-4, 1 Primary Route, 2 Secondary Route, 3 Primary Road and 4 Secondary Road) were used initially as wilderness inventory roads and field verified during the inventory process to determine if they met the FLPMA definition of a road. The northern boundary is along L105661, state land and the pass road. The eastern boundary is along the pass road and road L105644. The southern boundary is based on private land, and west Lincoln Gulch. The western boundary is based on Hwy 21, private land, state land and RT-293366.

(2) Does the area appear to be natural? Yes No N/A

Description (include land ownership, location, topography, vegetation, and summary of major human uses/activities

The unit is comprised of BLM land with state and private land within it. The unit is north of the Highway 21 approximately 2.5 miles north of Minersville, Utah. Portions of the area are steep and there are incised drainages throughout the unit. There are Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation treatments within the western portion of the unit. The vegetation treatments have been successful and consist of perennial grasses and perennial forbs. The majority of the northern and central portion of the unit is dominated by pinyon and juniper.

The unit does not meet the naturalness criteria due to the combination of developments including livestock fences, livestock troughs, vegetation treatments, major mining activity as well as motor vehicle routes and use including ATV and OHV is prevalent within the unit.
