Greetings,

Please be aware that the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) has not provided comment on the finding of effect for the December 2018 Oil and Gas Lease Sale (December 2018 LSCRR). Pursuant to 36 CFR 800.5(c)(3)(i), the Utah Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) National Historic Preservation Act Section 106 responsibilities regarding the December 2018 LSCRR are fulfilled. The BLM reaffirms the finding of No Adverse Effect, pursuant to 36 CFR 800.5 (c)(3)(ii)(B).

The following is a timeline of ACHP consultation for the December 2018 LSCRR:

- On November 9, 2018, Utah BLM invited ACHP to participate in Section 106 consultation for the December 2018 LSCRR.
- On November 13, 2018, ACHP acknowledged receipt via email of the request to consult on the December 2018 LSCRR.
- December 3, 2018 Nathan Thomas, BLM Utah' Deputy Preservation Officer, met with ACHP about the December 2018 lease sale.
- On December 10, 2018, BLM State Office Archaeologist Nicole Lohman called Chris Wilson at the ACHP at 12:08pm and left a message. Nicole Lohman and Oil and Gas Leasing Team Archaeologist Glenn Stelter called back at 1:06 pm and made contact with Acting BLM ACHP liaison Chris Wilson. Chris Wilson requested a 15-day extension to respond to Utah BLM's request to consult on the December 2018 LSCRR.
- December 25, 2018 BLM did not receive a response from the ACHP after the conclusion of the 15-day extended review period.
- February 8<sup>th</sup> 2019: issuance of lease

This decision concludes the Section 106 process for the December lease sale.
