

LEGEND

Roads and Trails Addressed by Environmental Assessment # ID-100-2009-EA-3711

- Roads inventoried under the Facilities Asset Management System (FAMS) which are currently subject to maintenance consideration by the BLM or other authorized entities.
- BLM designated roads, and motorized and non-motorized trails.

Roads Shown for Reference Only

- Roads crossing BLM lands which are subject to maintenance by holder of authorized rights-of-ways (ROWs) and not by the BLM.
- Roads accessing BLM lands, interests, or easements on which BLM may participate in maintenance.
- Frequently traveled non-BLM connector roads.

Travel Management Plan (TMP) Areas and Special Recreation Management Areas (SRMAs) where roads and trails have previously been designated for public use and authorized for maintenance (see specific management plans for identified areas).

Nationally designated Wilderness Areas and Wild and Scenic Rivers where future management plans will dictate road and trail maintenance operations.

Ground-based Military Operations Areas (MOAs) where interior roads and trails are not shown and maintenance is the responsibility of the U.S. Department of Defense or the State of Idaho.
