Dear Interested Party:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in conjunction with the Paradise Valley Weed District is proposing to treat up to 1,500 acres of public lands with BLM approved herbicides to control the establishment and spread of weeds and/or annual invasive species near Paradise Valley, Nevada.

The target species identified to be treated is Medusahead, an invasive annual species that has incrementally spread throughout Paradise Valley. Treatments would center on the three proposed treatment areas identified on the attached map.

The herbicide Imazapic would be used to treat the majority of the Medusahead infestation. Imazapic is a selective pre and post emergent herbicide that inhibits the growth of broadleaf weeds and annual grasses. Application methods of herbicides would include; truck or ATV with a boom mounted sprayer, by hand using backpack pumps, or by aircraft. All application methods would follow label directions and comply with BLM guidance and SOP's.
