## **Background**

On March 12, 2012, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Carson City District Office issued a Finding of No Significant Impact and Decision Record for the *Nevada Broadband Telemedicine Initiative Environmental Assessment* (DOI-BLM-NV-C020-2011-0512-EA). The Department of Commerce, National Telecommunications and Information Administration was the federal lead for compliance under the National Environmental Policy Act.

An *errata* is a list of errors and their corrections. None of the corrections contained in this errata caused a revision to an alternative, or the analysis therein.

## **Corrections**

The following corrections were identified by BLM staff in the Southern Nevada District Office, and are hereby made in the Final Environmental Assessment, issued on January 20, 2012.

A. On Page 72, Section 3.8.3, first paragraph, second sentence:

1. Change “The current allowable management level (AML)...” to “The current appropriate management level (AML)...”

B. On Page 72, Section 3.8.3, Table 3-11, under the “Allowable Management Levels (AMLs)” column, the following changes are hereby made:

1. Revise the title of the column from “Allowable Management Levels (AMLs)” to “Appropriate Management Level (AMLs).”
2. For the Johnnie HMA, under “Allowable Management Levels (AMLs),” change the “No. of Horses” from 50 to 0; and change the “No. of Burros” from 50 to 54-108.
3. For the Wheeler Pass HMA, under “Allowable Management Levels (AMLs),” change the “No. of Horses” from 0 to 47-66; and change the “No. of Burros” from 54-108 to 20-35.
4. For the Red Rock HMA, under “Allowable Management Levels (AMLs),” change the “No. of Horses” from 50 to 16-27; and change the “No. of Burros” from 50 to 29-49.

NOTE: None of these corrections had any bearing on the analysis contained in the Final EA.
