The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Winnemucca District (WD), Humboldt River Field Office has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Decision Record (DR) for the Grass Valley 120kV Transmission Line Right-of-way Environment Assessment (EA). The DR selects the Proposed Action for implementation.

The Grass Valley 120kV Project is for approximately 3,900 feet of new 120kV transmission line to include 25kV "underbuild" and 30' x 30' extension of the existing Grass Valley substation to reduce the power load placed on the 60kV power distribution system and improve reliability of service for the Winnemucca area. The project is located approximately 2 miles south of Winnemucca, Nevada on State Route 294/South Grass Valley Road, on approximately 19 acres of public lands.
