


FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended, the Bureau of Land Management, Central Yukon Field Office has assessed the environmental effects of the following action:

Land Use Permit (2920) Application FF096410
Removal Action Petroleum Contaminated Soil
Tanacross Airfield Site, Tanacross, Alaska

I have reviewed the attached Environmental Assessment DOI-BLM-AKF020-2012-0025-EA completed by the US Army Corps of Engineers and have concluded that the impacts of conducting remediation activities at the specified sites on public lands within the Tanacross Airfield Site (Copper River Meridian, Township 18 North, Range 11 East, section 5) have been adequately addressed. There are no impacts that approached the threshold of significance according to 40 CFR 1508.7. Therefore, I have determined that a Finding of No Significant Impact is appropriate and an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

The proposed action is not located within a geographic area covered by a Resource Management Plan or in the Fortymile Management Framework Plan (MFP) (September 1980).
