BLM Seeks Input on Grazing Permit Renewal for Pah Rah Allotment

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Sierra Front Field Office in Carson City, Nevada is preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) to analyze the impacts of re-issuing a grazing permit on the Pah Rah Allotment northeast of Reno Nevada. The Pah Rah Allotment is located approximately 24 miles northeast of Reno, Nevada, southwest of Pyramid Lake. This letter is to inform interested and affected parties of the alternatives the BLM is preparing to analyze, and to solicit comments to determine if other alternatives should be considered. The current grazing permit for the Allotment is 180 AUMs from September 1 to December 31. An additional alternative under consideration is to adjust the Season of Use from September 1 to December 31 to September 1 to November 15 with 180 AUMs.

For BLM consideration in the Environmental Assessment, we are asking the livestock permittee and the interested public to provide information, concerns and alternatives for the management of this Allotment.

All comments and information are welcome as we complete the permit renewal process for the Pah Rah Allotment. Comments will be most useful if received by August 1, 2012.

While you can ask us in your comment to withhold your personal identifying information from public review, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to do so
