Makoil, Inc. has submitted an Application for Permit to Drill (APD) for a wildcat oil and gas well in Railroad Valley, approximately six miles west of the town of Currant, Nye County, Nevada. Access would be from Highway 6 on approximately 12 miles of existing gravel roads. This project may be tiered to a similar project in Railroad Valley and a Determination of NEPA Adequacy (DNA) may be appropriate. Total project disturbance would less than five acres. Drilling water needed would be obtained by hauling water from an existing well located near the refinery. Operations would commence in late spring 2013.




MAKOIL'S PROPOSED EXPLORATION WELL PORTUGUESE MOUNTAIN 14-12
