**Questions and Answers**

*Is there a complete list of objects that are to be protected in the monument?*

-A complete list is available in the Proclamation and in the Proposed Resource Management Plan. BLM will work with participants individually to address specific needs.

*Are there going to be trails designated for ATVs?*

-No, but ATVs are permitted on motorized routes.

*What categories of roads permit use of bicycles?*

-Bicycles cannot go on non-motorized, non-mechanized routes (trails). But the public can ride on roads and primitive roads including administrative roads. Administrative use authorization is required to operate motorized vehicles on administrative roads; bicycles do not require authorization.
