**Map 3.14: Mechanized Non-motorized Uses**

This map shows the routes which would be available for mechanized non-motorized travel on Monument lands, including bicycles, and wagons or carts propelled by human or animal power. These routes include 'Roads', 'Primitive Roads', and 'Administrative Primitive Roads'.

Also shown are those routes that would NOT be available for mechanized non-motorized travel. These routes include those designated as 'Trail' for non-motorized travel, and those 'Closed' for restoration.

Transportation route designations were established concurrently with the land use allocation decisions in the Monument Resource Management Plan approved in February 2013.


-  Road (Passenger car access, two lane)

-  Primitive Road, (Type B- 4WD light truck access single Lane 10 ft. width)

-  Trail, Non-Mechanized Non-Motorized Access- Pedestrian and riding livestock
-  Decommissioned Route (Not a road or trail)- Restoration
-  Major County Rd

-  Monument Lands Administered by BLM


