


APS Proposed Right-of-Way Amendment

- APS has approval for a right-of-way (ROW) to relocate the Bagdad 115-kV power line south of the proposed stockpile extension.
- This approval permits construction and disturbance within the 100-foot ROW corridor.
- The approved ROW does not permit construction or improvement of roads outside the 100-foot ROW for power line maintenance.
- In February 2013, APS submitted a proposed amendment to the existing ROW to construct and improve roads necessary for future maintenance of the power line.
- Approximately 5 miles of road are proposed on BLM-managed lands, with approximately 30 acres of disturbance.
- The APS proposed roads are located within the same geographic area as the limited, future distributed facilities and would be granted for a 30-year term, with the potential for extension.
