


### **Milestones for 2010-2012 – Collection and Mapping of Existing Routes and Identification of Planning Issues**

In 2010, the VFO hired a contractor that specializes in travel management to make an inventory of all known routes located on BLM managed lands in Daggett, Duchesne, and Uintah Counties. During the summers of 2010 through 2012, an inventory was compiled which identified all known roads, 2-track routes, and single-track trails. To aid in the data-gathering process, the VFO provided BLM GIS data maps, transportation maps from the three counties, aerial photos, public comments, and BLM resource staff knowledge. During the inventory process, the contractor took hundreds of photos to help catalog features encountered such as stock ponds, watering troughs, gates, pasture fences, primitive camp sites, oil/gas pads, and general appearance.
