Aurion Resources Ltd. (Aurion) is proposing to conduct exploration activities in the Southpaw/Logan Pass Project area for gold using reverse circulation drilling. The proposed project would consist of 50 acres of surface disturbance associated with drill pad and road construction. Disturbance associated with the project would be phased and would take place over ten years.

Legal Location: Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Nevada;
T. 3 S., R. 59 E., Sections: 19, 20, 29, and 30;
T. 4 S., R. 58 E., Sections: 1, 2, 11, and 12; and
T. 4 S., R. 59 E., Sections: 6 and 7.
