The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Winnemucca District, Humboldt River Field Office is seeking public input as it initiates an Environmental Impact Statement for a modification to a Plan of Operations submitted by Coeur Rochester, Inc. (CRI). CRI submitted the *Coeur Rochester Mine Plan of Operations Amendment 10 Project (POA10)* to expand their existing mine operations located on public and private land located approximately 18 miles northeast of Lovelock, in Pershing County, Nevada.

The BLM will hold two public open-house meetings on the proposal from 5-7 p.m. in the following locations: Lovelock, Nevada on Wednesday, July 9, 2014, at the Lovelock Community Center, in the Seven Troughs/Rochester Room, located at 820 6th Street, and in Winnemucca, Nevada on Thursday, July 10, 2014, at the Winnemucca Convention Center, West Hall, located at 50 West Winnemucca Blvd. A project introduction and a slide presentation will be given at the beginning of each meeting, followed by an open-house.

Participation is encouraged, and comment forms will be available for your input at these meetings. The comment forms may be submitted at the public meetings or at any time through July 27, 2014, either by mail to Ms. Kathleen Rehberg, project lead, at the above address or by e-mail at wfoweb@blm.gov with "Coeur POA10 Project (Rehberg)" in the subject line.

Public comments submitted for this project, including names and addresses of commenters, will be available for public review at the WDO during regular business hours 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, except federal holidays. Before including your address, phone number, e-mail address, or other personal identifying information in your comment, you should be aware that your entire comment -- including personal identifying information -- may be made publicly available at any time. While you can ask us in your comment to withhold personal identifying information from public review, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to do so.
