The Bureau of Land Management has developed an environmental assessment DOI-BLM-NV-W010-2012-0032-EA (EA) for the renewal of the Pueblo Mountain Allotment Ten Year Grazing Permit and it is now available for public review and comment. The EA evaluates the proposed grazing system and management objectives that would meet the Standards for Rangeland Health (SRH) or make significant progress toward meeting these standards within the Pueblo Mountain Allotment.
