
## Schedule update for segments 8 and 9 in southwestern Idaho

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is conducting additional environmental review of segments 8 and 9 of the Gateway West Transmission Line Project in southwestern Idaho. The BLM is developing a supplemental environmental impact statement (SEIS). Scoping for the SEIS was completed in October 2014. The BLM gathered public input during scoping which will inform the draft SEIS. The SEIS will consider information that was not available when the final EIS was developed and additional, relevant information gathered during scoping.

With the completion of scoping, the schedule for the Gateway West SEIS has been revised.

- The draft SEIS will be published in September 2015 (rather than June).
- There will be a 90-day public comment period (September-December 2015), with public meetings during that time.
- The final SEIS will be published in April 2016, with a Record of Decision (ROD) in June 2016.
- The revised schedule will not allow for any extension of the comment period for the draft SEIS.



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## About the project

The Gateway West Transmission Line Project is jointly proposed by Rocky Mountain Power and Idaho Power to build, operate, and maintain approximately 1,000 miles of new 230 kilovolt (kV) and 500 kV electric transmission lines across southern Wyoming and southern Idaho.
