- Permits:** A guide shall not provide guide services related to fishing and hunting on public land or public waters without having the necessary special use permit issued by the federal land management agency having jurisdiction within the wildlife management area or unit.
- Contracts:** Before providing a service to a client, a licensed master guide must furnish the client with a contract meeting the requirements of NAC 504.665. A master guide shall provide the client with a contract signed by the master guide within 30 days after receipt of deposit for future guide services.
- Client Records:** Master guides shall keep and have available complete, current and accurate records regarding their clients pursuant to NAC 504.667. The master guide shall present his client records for inspection at any reasonable hour or place to a game warden. The master guide shall submit all record forms for his clients including subguide records, no later than December 31 of the year for which the guide is currently licensed.
- Possession of license and permit:** At all times while transporting, providing guide service to or otherwise in the company of a client, a master guide or subguide shall carry on his person or otherwise readily available his valid master guide or subguide license or a legible, unaltered copy of the license; and if applicable a valid original or legible, unaltered copy of the permit issued by the federal land management agency having jurisdiction within the wildlife management area or unit, and annual letter of authorization issued by the Bureau of Land Management as applicable.

* Nevada Master guide license may be revoked or suspended as provided under Title 45, NAC 504.671.
