Decision

It is my decision to implement the proposed action on BLM-managed lands as described in the attached Categorical Exclusion documentation, DOI-BLM-AK-F020-2015-0009-CX.

Rationale

The proposed action has been reviewed by Eastern Interior Field Office staff and appropriate Project Design Features, as specified, will be incorporated during project implementation. Based on the attached Categorical Exclusion review, I have determined that the proposed action involves no significant impact to the human environment and no further analysis is required.

There are no anticipated impacts to cultural resources. The proposed action will not significantly restrict subsistence uses. There are no expected effects to Essential Fish Habitat.

Appeals from administrative decisions issued by BLM-Alaska must be filed in writing in the office of the deciding official, either by mail or hand delivery. Notices of appeal transmitted by electronic means, such as facsimile or e-mail will not be accepted as timely filed.
