SPECIAL RECREATION PERMIT NV0300-13-05 ISSUED

Dear Mr. Moss,

Based on the application and stipulations related to the Special Recreation Permit (SRP NV0300-13-05) including NEPA document DOI-BLM-NV-E000-2015-0008-CX the Elko Office has decided to issue a ten-year Statewide Outfitter and Guide Special Recreation Permit (SRP). The Elko District Office will serve as the lead for this permit as allowed by NV-IM-2010-060, and by authorized agreements received from Winnemucca, Battle Mountain, Ely, and Southern Nevada Districts. The permit is active from July 1, 2015 through May 31, 2025. In order to maintain this permit it must be validated prior to expiration every year through the submission of:

- Estimated use report/plan of annual operations due August 1st
- Post use report/NDOW Client Record Form
- Annual gross receipt fees of 3% due May 31st

SRP NV0300-13-05 allows the permit holder to conduct Outfitting and Guiding operations on BLM managed land within Nevada Department of Wildlife (NDOW) hunt areas ONLY. Access to private inholdings or any other federally or state/locally held parcels must be granted PRIOR to occupation. The permittee has the sole responsibility of verifying land management status and ownership while conducting operations within Nevada. The permittee could be subject to any and all associated penalties for activities conducted outside the permitted area and on land holdings other than BLM managed parcels.

As a reminder there are some special stipulations associated with your permit that reflect issues raised by the resource staff within each office. Particularly Mossback Outfitters is to contact the Southern Nevada District directly for EVERY hunt booked prior to conducting operations in that area. In addition to guiding operations, filming of wildlife and hunting activities associated with this permit are granted per IM-NV-2010-064 as stipulated. Strict adherence to filming stipulations is mandatory the violation of which will result in the revocation of the SRP. Additionally, Mossback Outfitters will refrain from harassing livestock, and ensure that gates, and other such range management equipment are closed and secure after opening to maintain grazing allotment objectives.

Thank you for choosing to operate in Nevada, and recreating on our nation's public lands. Please respect our national heritage by practicing appropriate outdoor ethics such as Leave No Trace®, and Tread Lightly™, and limit the spread of noxious weeds by thoroughly cleaning equipment before and after you travel on to public lands.
