Dear Reader,

The Wells Field Office has completed the Curtis Spring Term Permit Renewal Environmental Assessment (EA). This EA addresses the renewal of the livestock grazing permit for the Curtis Spring Allotment located in south central Elko County.

On 21 May 2015 the BLM issued a scoping letter, indicating the BLMs intent to renew the Curtis Spring Allotment grazing permit. This letter asked the interested public to submit any comments, data or information to be considered in developing the S&G Assessment. No comments were received. On 14 August 2015 the BLM mailed a letter notifying the interested public that the BLM had completed the Draft S&G Assessment and that this assessment was posted to the NEPA Register website. This letter asked the public to provide input relevant to the development of alternatives to be considered in this Environmental Assessment. No comments or input were received.

The EA and an unsigned Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) are posted for public review on the NEPA Register website at: <https://tinyurl.com/ldevsz2>. The 30 day comment period will end 22 June 2017.

Following this comment period, BLM will issue a Final S&G Assessment for the Curtis Spring Allotment, a signed FONSI if appropriate, and a Grazing Permit Renewal Decision.
