A. Background

BLM Office: Monticello Field Office

Lease/Serial/Case File No: UTU-91500

Proposed Action Title/Type: Film Permit

Locations of Proposed Action: At climbing locations on North Six Shooter (Lightning Bolt Cracks) and Bridger Jack Mesa (King of Pain Spire) in Indian Creek.

Description of Proposed Action:

On November 19, 2015, Camp4 Collective, filed film permit application UTU-91500 proposing four days of filming between December 18 thru 21, 2015. The company has proposed the following filming activities and equipment:



- Filming two climbers (talent) on the Lightning Bolt Cracks located on the North Six Shooter formation and on the King of Pain area of the Bridger Jack Spires.
 - The talent will be filmed along the proposed climbing routes by another climbing party located above them.
 - Rigging ahead of the talent will consist of several ropes set by the other climbing party.
 - A typical climbing party consists of two climbers.
- All film will be captured with 45 individual GoPro cameras.
- The proposal also includes use of an Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) operated by Elevated Productions LLC. The UAS is proposed for use at both locations.
- The total number of people on the shoot consists of 15 talent and crew.
- They will utilize 8 passenger vehicles to transport the crew and talent.
- Vehicle access to the Bridger Jack Spires is proposed via Beef Basin Road (B107) and D roads that access Bridger Jack Campground (D0498 and D0459), see Figure 1.
- Vehicle access to the North Six Shooter is proposed via D0569 which provides access from north side of North Six Shooter, see Figure 1.
- Climber trails will then be used to access the climbing routes from vehicle access roads.

No surface disturbance is expected because the crew will complete filming on existing trails and disturbed areas. The following stipulations will be added to the permit to mitigate impacts to raptors:

- Climbers and drones will not harass or harm any wildlife. If raptors or nests are observed during climbing/filming they will inform the BLM immediately.

FAA UAS Limitations:

Elevated Productions LLC is authorized by the FAA to operate a Mid Atlantic X18 quad copter weighing less than 55 pounds, traveling at less than 100 miles per hour, and below 400 feet above ground level. The UAS must be operated within the visual line of site of both the pilot and visual observer.

Figure 1: Locations and Access Routes




Figure 2: The Bridger Jack Spires




Figure 3: North Six Shooter

B. Land Use Plan Conformance

Land Use Plan Name: Monticello Field Office RMP, Approved November 2008

The proposed action is in conformance with the applicable LUP because it is specifically provided for in the following LUP decision(s):

LAR-6

Filming permit authorizations are subject to Public Law 106-206. Applications for filming permits in the Monticello PA will be limited to existing highways, roads, and pullouts and previously disturbed or cleared areas throughout the Field Office (including Valley of the Gods, Moki Dugway, Highway 211, Newspaper Rock, and Highway 95) and will have to meet criteria of minimal impact to be approved without any NEPA analysis.

C. Compliance with NEPA

The Proposed Action is categorically excluded from further documentation under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) in accordance with 516 DM 11.9(E)19. This reference states "issuance of short-term (3 years or less) rights-of-way or land use authorizations... where the proposal includes rehabilitation to restore the land to its natural or original condition."

This categorical exclusion is appropriate in this situation because there are no extraordinary circumstances potentially having effects that may significantly affect the environment. The proposed action has been reviewed, and none of the extraordinary circumstances described in 43 CFR Part 46.215 will apply.
