


Forest Management Tour in the Jumping Bean Area

The Grants Pass Field Office invites you to personally view previous BLM forest management treatments, similar to the types of treatments proposed in this Cold Elk Project. This forest management tour is close to Interstate 5 and Grants Pass. These units were part of the Jumping Bean Timber Sale and were treated in 2015. If you choose to make this trip, please plan accordingly: Check the weather forecast, bring appropriate clothing and equipment, and tell someone where you are going. This tour may take approximately 5 hours.



Stop 1: Unit 9-16, 2015 Variable Density Thin (VDT), tractor yarding (2 acres), cable yarding (19 acres)

Stop 3: Unit 15-15A, 2015 VDT, tractor yarding 20 acres; Unit 15-15B, 2015 VDT, cable yarding (9 acres)

Stop 2: Unit 9-2, 2015 VDT, cable yarding (13 acres)
