

T 29N, R 108W, SW 1/4 Sec. 1





Although the polygon used for this exercise is greater than 5000 acres, it is developed heavily as a natural gas field and there are clearly no roadless areas greater than 5000 acres within its boundaries. In addition, due to the industrialized nature of this polygon, there are clearly no polygons within its boundaries that meet the criteria outlined on Page 8 of the 2011 version 6301 LWC manual for areas less than 5000 acres.
