Road Maintenance on the Quebradas Backcountry Byway

Finding of No Significant Impact

Based on the analysis of potential environmental impacts discussed in the attached Categorical Exclusion, a Finding of No Significant Impact is not required. An Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

Compliance with Statutes, Regulations, and Land Use Plans

The proposed action is in conformance with the terms and the conditions of the *Socorro Field Office Resource Management Plan*, approved in August of 2010 (BLM/NM/PL-10-03-1617), as required by 43 CFR 1610.6.

The proposed action is also in compliance with the following statutes and regulations:

- Federal Land Policy and Management Act
- National Historic Preservation Act
- Endangered Species Act
- Clean Water Act
- Clean Air Act
- Executive Order (EO) 13112, Invasive weeds
- New Mexico Noxious Weeds Management Act of 1978

Decision

It is my decision to authorize the proposed action which is to authorize road maintenance on the Quebradas Backcountry National Scenic Byway within the original disturbance beginning in Township 2 South, Range 1 East, Section 30, and ending in Township 4 South, Range 2 East, Section 25.

Rationale for Decision

The Socorro Field Office is directed by its Resource Management Plan to: “Maintain the byway open to motor vehicle use”, “Allow mineral material disposals within the buffer area contingent upon site-specific assessment of resources and mitigation as necessary”, and “Maintain existing Socorro County Road Maintenance agreement” (page 59).

Protest and Appeal

This decision shall take effect immediately upon the date it is signed by the Authorized Officer and shall remain in effect while any appeal is pending unless the Interior Board of Land Appeals issues a stay (43 CFR 2801.10(b)). Any appeal of this decision must follow the procedures set forth in 43 CFR Part 4. Within 30 days of the decision, a notice of appeal must be filed in the office of the Authorized Officer at:

If a statement of reasons for the appeal is not included with the notice, it must be filed with the Interior Board of Land Appeals within 30 days after the notice of appeal is filed with the Authorized Officer.
