#### **Finding of No Significant Impact**

Based on the analysis of potential environmental impacts discussed in the attached Determination of NEPA Adequacy, a Finding of No Significant Impact was reached and signed on March 21, 2016. An Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

#### **Compliance with Statutes, Regulations, and Land Use Plans**

The proposed action is in conformance with the terms and the conditions of the *Socorro Field Office Resource Management Plan*, approved in August of 2010 (BLM/NM/PL-10-03-1617), as required by 43 CFR 1610.6.

The proposed action is also in compliance with the following statutes and regulations:

- National Historic Preservation Act
- Endangered Species Act
- Clean Water Act
- Clean Air Act
- Executive Order (EO) 13112, Invasive weeds

#### **Decision**

It is my decision to authorize the proposed action which is to authorize the collection of core soil samples in 5 playas and in the Chupadero Arroyo. Collection locations are in Township 4 South, Range 4 East; Township 5 South, Range 4 East; and Township 8 South, Range 1 East. Specific geographic locations of the core samples are proprietary.

#### **Rationale for Decision**

The Socorro Field Office is directed by its Resource Management Plan and guided by its goals: “within the capability of the Planning Area’s natural and cultural resources, provide tourism, recreational, educational, and research opportunities”.

**Protest and Appeal**

This decision shall take effect immediately upon the date it is signed by the Authorized Officer and shall remain in effect while any appeal is pending unless the Interior Board of Land Appeals issues a stay (43 CFR 2801.10(b)). Any appeal of this decision must follow the procedures set forth in 43 CFR Part 4. Within 30 days of the decision, a notice of appeal must be filed in the office of the Authorized Officer at:
