In March of 2015, BLM conducted a Class I inventory of the proposed **Twin Creek Existing 13.8 kV Powerline ROW Renewal Project, Fremont County, Wyoming** (Report No. 050-2015-053).

Recommended Stipulations:

1. **CULTURAL AND PALEONTOLOGICAL RESOURCES, STANDARD STIPULATION.** Any cultural and/or paleontological resource (historic or prehistoric site or object or fossil) discovered by the holder, or any person working on his behalf, on public or Federal land shall be immediately reported to the authorized officer. Holder shall suspend all operations in the immediate area of such discovery until written authorization to proceed is issued by the authorized officer. An evaluation of the discovery will be made by the authorized officer to determine appropriate actions to prevent the loss of significant cultural or scientific values. The holder will be responsible for the cost of evaluation and any decision as to proper mitigation measures shall be made by the authorized officer after consulting with the holder.
