Finding of No Significant Impact

Based on the analysis of potential environmental impacts discussed in the attached Determination of NEPA Adequacy (DNA), a Finding of No Significant Impact was reached and signed on July 25, 2016. An Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

Rationale for Decision

The Socorro Field Office is directed by its Resource Management Plan to: "Ensure optimum populations of and a natural abundance and diversity of wildlife resources on public land by restoring, maintaining, and enhancing habitat conditions through management plans and actions integrated with other uses of public land through coordination with other programs, management initiatives, and habitat enhancement

projects, while mitigating and/or reducing adverse impacts of other resource uses and human-wildlife interactions.” Page 48.

Protest and Appeal


This decision shall take effect immediately upon the date it is signed by the Authorized Officer and shall remain in effect while any appeal is pending unless the Interior Board of Land Appeals issues a stay (43 CFR 2801.10(b)). Any appeal of this decision must follow the procedures set forth in 43 CFR Part 4. Within 30 days of the decision, a notice of appeal must be filed in the office of the Authorized Officer at:

If a statement of reasons for the appeal is not included with the notice, it must be filed with the Interior Board of Land Appeals within 30 days after the notice of appeal is filed with the Authorized Officer.
