
**Northwest Pipeline Proposed Right-of-Way for  
Cathodic Protection Station 1651  
UTU-91678**

**FONSI:** Based on the analysis of potential environmental impacts contained in environmental assessment UT-Y020-2016-0037-EA, and considering the significance criteria in 40 CFR 1508.27, I have determined that authorizing right-of-way UTU-91678 for Cathodic Protection Station (CPS) #1651 will not have a significant effect on the human environment. An environmental impact statement is therefore not required.

**DECISION:** It is my decision to select the proposed action as described in DOI-BLM-UT-Y020-2016-0037-EA and authorize right-of-way UTU-91678 for the use of public lands to construct, operate, maintain, and terminate a cathodic protection station. The authority for my decision is provided in Section 28 of the Mineral leasing Act (MLA) of 1920, as amended (30 U.S.C. 185), and the Federal regulations at 43 CFR 2880.

**RATIONAEL:** My decision to authorize ROW UTU-91678 is based on the following:

- The ID team indicated that all resources were either not present or will not be impacted by the construction of CPS #1651.
- No issues were identified by the public after the Proposed Action was posted on BLM's ePlanning website on May 02, 2016.
- The Plan of Development provided by the applicant, Northwest Pipeline LLC, will be incorporated as terms and conditions of the authorizing right-of-way grant.
