### Decision:

It is my decision to approve the Special Recreation Permit (SRP) which authorizes **Pete Cimellaro dba Yellowhorn Outfitters** to conduct a commercial guided big game hunt on public lands located in Arizona Game and Fish Department game management unit 40A administered by the Lower Sonoran Field Office as described in the proposed action on the attached NEPA document. The permit will be effective from December 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015 and will remain in effect for the approved time period providing the permittee remains in good standing by complying with all terms, conditions and stipulations.

### Rationale for Decision:

The proposed action is in conformance with the *Lower Sonoran RMP* approved September 2012, the *Sonoran Desert National Monument RMP* approved September, 2012, and the "*Special Recreation Permits for Commercial Recreation Activities on Public Lands in Arizona*" Environmental Assessment, approved August 1993. Existing NEPA documentation covers the proposed action and constitutes BLM's compliance with the requirements of NEPA. This decision has no adverse impact on energy development, production, supply and/or distribution. Terms, conditions and stipulations addressed in the EA, and included with the permit, should ensure protection of the sensitive resources in the proposed areas. Compliance monitoring will be conducted to ensure these measures are followed and no significant impacts occur.

### Mitigation Measures/Stipulations:

No specific mitigation measures or stipulations were identified by resource specialists. The attached Phoenix District Office BLM SRP Stipulations for Commercial Hunting Guides and Outfitters" are hereby incorporated into this proposed action.
