10 YEAR PERMIT RENEWAL FOR TESTOLIN GUIDE SERVICE AND VALIDATION OF SRP-NV-0200-16-02 FOR THE 2016/2017 HUNTING SEASON

Based on the application and stipulations related to the Special Recreation Permit (NV-0200-16-02) including NEPA document DOI-BLM-NV-E000-2016-0003-CX, the Elko District Office has decided to validate and issue a Special Recreation Permit (SRP). Enclosed is one signed copy of the Special Recreation Permit (i.e. BLM form 2930-2) SRP-NV-0200-16-02. This Special Recreation Permit (SRP) will authorize your company to conduct Outfitting and Guiding Operations on BLM-managed lands in the State of Nevada, with concurrence pending in other BLM Districts and on a trip-by-trip basis in the Southern Nevada District Office. The SRP will be valid from August 1, 2016 to May 31, 2025 and subject to all the terms and conditions as stipulated in the enclosed documents.

YOU MUST COMPLY WITH THE STIPULATIONS ON THE BACK OF YOUR PERMIT AND THE SPECIAL STIPULATIONS THAT ARE ATTACHED TO YOUR PERMIT. You and any sub-guides working for you must have the Special Recreation Permit and Special Stipulations in possession when conducting any guiding activities on public lands.

A Post Use Report is due after your season of use but no later than **May 31, 2017** to this BLM Office. Fees are due at this time or within 30 days of submitting your post use report (fees are 3% of your gross earnings). May 31st is also your due date for yearly Validation (or renewal). By May 31st of each year you must submit your Post Use Report and fees, a new Plan of Operations for the upcoming season, a valid Insurance Certificate, and a current copy of your NDOW Master Guide License.

Failure to submit the required documents by the due dates will result in your permit being placed in probationary status or termination of your 10 year permit.
