Dear Reader:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) received Expressions of Interest (nominations) to sell Federal oil and gas leases on 156 parcels of Federal minerals in a future lease sale. The parcels are located within the Miles City Field Office (MCFO) area. The preliminary parcel list with recommended stipulations for the 156 parcels is posted on the BLM e-Planning website, listed below, for a 15-day scoping period for your review starting on October 5, 2016.

The BLM makes mineral resources available for use to meet national, regional, and local needs. Under the Federal Onshore Oil and Gas Leasing Reform Act of 1987, the BLM conducts oil and gas lease sales quarterly in each state whenever eligible lands are available for leasing. Prior to offering nominated parcels for lease at a sale, if analysis is warranted, the BLM will complete an environmental assessment (EA) to disclose the potential impacts from issuing Federal oil and gas leases and identify stipulations that would be included with each lease.

We have posted a preliminary parcel list with recommended stipulations on the BLM e-Planning website for your review. Please refer to the BLM e-Planning website for updated information and associated documents pertaining to this sale at <http://1.usa.gov/1QyUex8>. Select *NEPA* as the *Type of Project* and complete a *Text Search* for DOI-BLM-MT-C020-2016-0134-EA.
